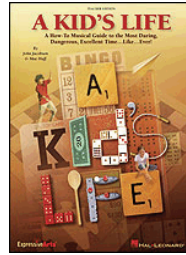

The Summer Reading Program for children and teens at the Franklin Public Library will be held June 14 through July 10, with the theme "Make a Splash at Your Library!"
