120.01 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CHIEF OR DIRECTOR OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

The Fire Chief or Fire Department Director shall be responsible for the enforcement of laws, City ordinances, and governmental regulations related to fire, to develop, implement, and administer fire prevention programs and training programs for fire personnel.

He shall, at all times, keep a complete inventory of the property connected with the Fire Department and shall keep a record of all fires occurring in the City, giving the date, locality, building, origin, estimated loss, and such other data as may be necessary. The Fire Department Chief shall have sole command at all fires over the members of the Fire Department, and while on duty, the Fire Chief and each member of the Fire Department shall have police powers at all fires in matters connected with the faithful discharge of their duties. A copy of the inventory of the property shall be delivered to the City Manager and all changes and modifications made from time to time to said inventory shall forthwith be supplied to the City Manager.
