160.01. Commission Established.

The commission is hereby established which will be known as the Parking Commission of the City of Franklin, and is hereinafter designated "the Commission". (Ord. 7 of 1987, Sect. 1, Passed 11-2-87)

160.02. Composition of Commission.

- (a) The Commission shall be composed of five (5) adult citizens of the City of Franklin, hereinafter designated the commissioners.
- (b) The commissioners shall serve without compensation.
- (c) The commissioners shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council of the City to serve for a term of five (5) years; and a vacancy in the office of the commission shall be filled by appointment of the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council of the City for the unexpired term.
- (d) The first commissioners shall be appointed so that one commissioner shall have a term of five (5) years, the second a term of four (4) years, the third a term of three (3) years, the fourth a term of two (2) years, and the fifth a term of one (1) year, and thereafter, as commissioners are appointed, shall serve for the designated term of five (5) years.

160.03. Duties of Commission.

The Commission shall conduct such studies as it believes necessary to make recommendations to the Council of the City for the establishment, maintenance and regulation of parking areas in the City of Franklin, and recommend the regulation and installation of parking meters on the streets of the City of Franklin. 160.04. Report of Commission.

The Parking Commission shall annually report to the Council of the City at the first stated meeting in October of each year of its studies and recommendations, and at such other times as it deems necessary to make recommendations to the Council of the City." (Ord. 7 of 1987, Sect. 1, Passed 11-2-87)
